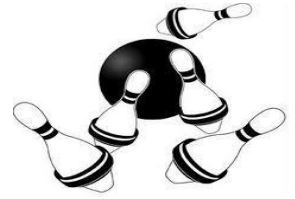

On behalf of the City of Port Coquitlam and our Council, we are proud to welcome competitors from across British Columbia and are excited to host another great weekend of five-pin bowling.

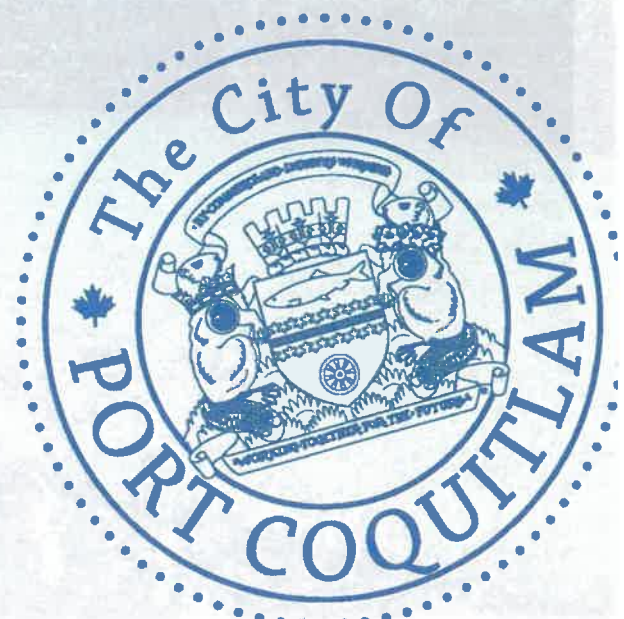

PROVINCIAL OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Provincial Championships shall be bowled April 2-5, 2026 at Poco Bowl, Port Coquitlam, BC.
2. **PERSONAL BOWLING BALLS**: Personal bowling balls are allowed for this tournament. Only two (2) balls per person will be allowed on the rack during each game. If your balls are not yet back on the rack when it is time for your next turn, you must use a house ball. You may notify the Judge of Play, but the game must not be held up while you wait for your own balls to be returned. It is the bowler's responsibility to make sure that all personal bowling balls meet Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association specifications.
3. **SLOW PLAY**: Teams found to be taking longer than the allotted time of one hour and five minutes per game (without just cause - i.e. pinsetter breakdown) will be first, issued a warning that they are abusing the time schedule and that they are requested to speed up their play to fit the schedule. If the same team has to be approached a second time, **a monetary penalty infraction of \$25** will be issued. If that is not enough of a deterrent, then a "shortened game" rule will be instituted where teams will stop play at the frame in progress and scores recorded as complete.
4. All singles competitors (men and ladies) shall bowl a qualifying round consisting of ten (10) games. At the conclusion of the qualifying round the top five (5) men and five (5) ladies based on total pinfall shall advance to a stepladder match play final. **THE FIRST PLACE QUALIFIER IN THE STEPLADDER FINAL MUST BE BEATEN TWICE.**
5. In the event of a tie in the singles competition for any of the five (5) stepladder positions, a one (1) game roll-off shall decide the higher placing.
6. In the event of a tie in the singles competition during the stepladder finals, an extra game or games shall be bowled to determine the winner.
7. **A singles competitor may select a coach to accompany them in the bowler's enclosure. The selected coach must be in uniform and must be a fully certified upgraded Level 2 or Competitive Coach Certified in the National Coaching Certification Program.**
8.
 - a) The single participants will come from the top six (6) men and top six (6) ladies to a maximum of three (3) men and three (3) ladies per zone asked in order of finish at the end of the zone finals. If a singles qualifier is unable to compete at the Provincial Championships, the next place qualifier shall be asked in order of finish from the zone finals.
 - b) All other positions on the Contingent shall be filled by the seventh (7th) and/or tenth (10) place man or the seventh (7th) and/or tenth (10th) place lady or vice versa, whichever the case may be, from the zone finals.
9. In all team events, bowl five (5) and count five (5).

RULES AND REGULATIONS - cont'd

- 10. The Men's, Ladies and Mixed teams shall bowl three (3) games against each zone for a total fifteen (15) games.
- 11. A match play format shall be used to determine the Champions in all team events. Each bowler who beats their opponent on the opposing team shall receive one (1) point. Three (3) points shall be awarded to the team that has a higher pinfall for the game, making a total of eight (8) points maximum for the game.

RESULT: Team A - 3 plus 3 = 6 points Team B - 2 plus 0 = 2 points

- 12. In the event of a tie between teams or individuals in any game during match play in the team events, all available points shall be divided equally between the tied teams or individuals.
- 13. **The top four (4) teams in each division (Men's, Ladies, Mixed), based on points accumulated in the match play qualifying round, will advance to the stepladder final with 4 & 3 playing, winner then plays 2, winner then plays the first-place qualifier. The first-place qualifier must be beaten twice.**
- 14. In the event of a tie or ties in total points for any positions, after completion of match play, the ties shall be broken by reverting back to the games bowled between said teams, and on a points won or lost basis, the higher placing shall be decided. If a tie still exists, the team with the most pinfall for the games bowled between the said teams shall receive the higher placing.
- 15. The starting line-up for the first (1st) game only of any team event must not include a replacement bowler -- i.e.: the line-up must be five (5) original qualifiers from the zone finals.
- 16. In each game the team assigned by lane draw to the **RIGHT-HAND LANE** shall be the **"HOME"** team and the team on the **LEFT-HAND** lane shall be the **"AWAY"** team. The Coach for the **"AWAY"** team is obliged to submit the line-up for a game before the line-up for the **"HOME"** team is submitted.
- 17. **10th Frame Rule** – The home team will have the option of who throws first in the tenth frame. Each bowler will throw one ball each until the frame has been completed. Once the next two bowlers are up, the home team will again get to choose who will throw first. This will continue until the match has been completed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS – cont'd

18. Any team that does not have a full complement of bowlers shall bowl only with the bowlers on hand. Late bowlers shall start to bowl and count only from the time of arrival, regardless of the reason. This rule also applies to singles competition.
19. In all team events the order of bowling may be changed for each game (unrestricted line-up and substitution).
20. Substitutions may be made at any time, but the bowler being substituted may not bowl again in the same game. One (1) substitution per game shall be allowed in all team events.
21. At the completion of each game, teams shall remain at their respective lanes. When instructed to do so, they shall move to their next lanes as per the lane draw. The lead-off bowler shall await the starting signal.
22. Lead-off bowlers shall not start the next frame until their anchor bowler has finished. A penalty of fifteen (15) pins shall be assessed said bowler for violating this rule and any ball or balls so thrown shall be declared "dead".
23. In all team events only bowlers competing in the event, coaches, and tournament officials shall be permitted in the bowler's enclosure. Any persons violating this rule shall be removed from the premises.
24. Only a bowler taking their regular turn in the line-up shall be allowed on the approach at any given time. All other bowlers on the team and the coach must remain off the approach to the side or behind the score stand.
25. Only non-playing coaches shall be allowed. "Coach" designation shall appear on the shirt or blouse.
26. Team score sheets must be signed by the Coach after each game. Score sheets filled out improperly or not signed **may result in a monetary penalty of \$25. Any further infractions will also be assessed a \$25 fee to the zone.**
27. There shall be a thirty (30) minute warm-up preceding each block.
28. All games shall start when the Judge of Play gives the starting signal.
29. Any bowler who throws a ball prior to the starting signal shall be assessed a fifteen (15) pin penalty. If the bowler is not in the starting line-up the penalty shall be assessed against the team. Any ball or balls so thrown shall be declared "dead".

RULES AND REGULATIONS – cont'd

30. Bowlers who wish to leave the bowler's enclosure should inform the Judge of Play.
31. No food or beverage of any kind shall be permitted in the bowler's enclosure. Bowlers or coaches violating this rule may be removed from the tournament by the Judge of Play.
32. The lane draw is pre-drawn under the auspices of the Provincial Association Tournament Committee.
33. **DRESS CODE** – Each team must be dressed uniformly. Individuals on a team must wear bottoms in the same colour but each may wear a different length/style bottom. Dress pants, skirts, skorts, dress shorts or capris shall have a straight hemmed bottom (no denim of any colour, stirrups, see-through or sheer leggings, harem, cargo, ruggers or sweatpants of any kind. No draw strings or no elastic at the hem of any kind. No draw strings or no elastic at the hem of any kind). The dress pants, skirts, skorts capris or dress shorts shall not be faded, torn, ripped, contain studs, buttons or pockets on the legs. The skirts, skorts or dress shorts may not be shorter than just below the fingertips when placing your arms at your side. When patterned dress pants, skirts, skorts, dress shorts or capris are chosen (ie. Loudmouth) as part of a zone uniform, the colours in the pattern must be in the zone colours and be approved by the BC5PBA Executive.

Bowling shirts or blouses must have sleeves, a collar and be of the same design in registered zone colours with appropriate identification. A ladies style shirt is permissible and can be with or without buttons but must have a finished neckline.

Bowlers may have up to 24 square inches of sponsorship logos and or identification on each shirt. Sponsors may vary between individuals and may not be in conflict with sponsors of the C5BPA.

No hats or caps or other headgear are allowed unless worn for religious or medical reasons.

34. For interpretation of any rules or controversy of any kind, stop play on your set of lanes and call the Judge of Play IMMEDIATELY.
35. Flagrant violation of any rules may result in penalties being assessed by the Provincial Association Tournament Committee.
36. The Judge of Play shall make all rulings and decisions shall be subject to appeal to the Provincial Association Tournament Committee.

RULES AND REGULATIONS – cont'd

37. The Provincial Aggregate Banner shall be awarded to the Zone Association that finishes with the most aggregate points based on the Contingent's standing in the following events: Men's and Ladies' Singles; Men's, Ladies' & Mixed Teams. The Aggregate Point System to be used shall be determined by the Provincial Association.
38. During the stepladder event, a bowler may concede their match, with the permission of the Tournament Director, if and only when they are mathematically eliminated from winning said match.

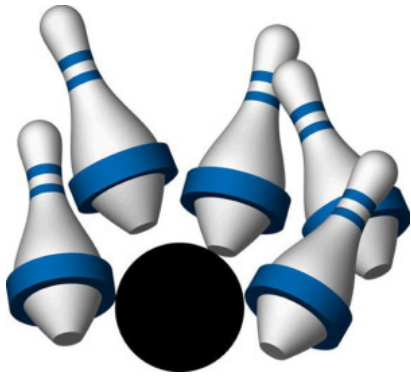
